

NOTICE OF YOUR RIGHTS

To protect your privacy, please take note that the information from the Special Master's Recommendation on your Individual Allocation Amount as shown on the previous page has been filed under seal of the Court. You have up to and including **March 12, 2008**, to object to the proposed recommendation of the Special Master. If you are dissatisfied with your Allocation, failure to file a written objection postmarked on or before **March 12, 2008**, will bar you from any further appeal of this matter.

TO REJECT THIS ALLOCATION AND FILE AN OBJECTION PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING VERY CAREFULLY

IF YOU OBJECT TO YOUR ALLOCATION, YOU MUST FILE A WRITTEN STATEMENT providing your full name, address, telephone number, claimant file number, the last four digits of your social security number, the reason(s) for your objection and any evidence supporting your objection, and a statement that you are objecting to your Allocation amount. **This written statement must be sent to the Nairn Special Master, P.O. Box 60600, New Orleans, Louisiana 70160-0600, and postmarked no later than midnight of March 12, 2008, or it will not be considered by the Special Master.** If you receive any communication from the Special Master and a response is required, you must comply with the request since the Special Master is an arm of the Court and is acting under the Court's authority.

Upon receipt of your objection, the Special Master will delete your proposed Allocation amount. In your objection, you will be required to prove the Allocation amount that you are entitled to as if no prior Allocation was made. The Special Master may determine that you are entitled to no Allocation, a lesser amount than that shown on this document, the same amount, or a greater amount, but you must provide the evidence to support your objection and the Special Master's finding. After submission of your objection to the Special Master, you will be notified later to appear at an Objection Hearing that will take place in a courtroom, located at 500 Poydras Street, New Orleans, Louisiana. If you fail to appear, your objection will be denied. After conclusion of the hearing on your objection, if you are satisfied with the findings of the Special Master, you need not do anything further. When all appeals that have been filed are final, you will be notified of how, when and where to get your Allocation.
