Dear Claimant:

**PLEASE READ THIS LETTER VERY CAREFULLY AS IT AFFECTS
YOUR RIGHTS IN THE CAPTIONED LAWSUIT.**

You have filed an objection to your proposed allocation. Your objection is scheduled to be heard before me at the **United States District Court located at 500 Poydras Street, Courtroom No. C-311, New Orleans, Louisiana 70130 on the following date and time:**

April _____, 2008, at _____ o'clock _____ .M.

On that date, you must appear in person to present your sworn testimony regarding your reasons why you think your allocation is incorrect. You may request that Class Counsel and/or your private attorney assist you in presenting your objection at the hearing. A copy of this Hearing Notice will be sent to your attorney of record or Class Counsel.

Absent good cause shown, new documents **not** provided with your written objection may not be considered. You must be prepared to provide a reasonable explanation if documents you submitted with your objection were not timely provided; otherwise, said documents may be disregarded.

Your entire claim will be reconsidered. At the conclusion of the hearing, it may be determined that you are entitled to a larger share of the settlement fund, in which case your allocation amount will be increased; it may be determined that you are entitled to less than your allocation amount, not more, in which case your allocation amount will be decreased; it may be determined that you are not entitled to any allocation amount, in which case your allocation amount will be zero; or, it may be determined that your allocation amount is correct, in which case your allocation amount will remain the same.

At the conclusion of the hearing, if you are not satisfied with the decision of the Special Master, you will have the right to appeal that decision to the Court. A full explanation of those appeal rights will be provided to you in writing at the conclusion of your hearing.

Absolutely no food or drink or weapons of any type may be brought into the courthouse or courtroom. You will be required to pass through a security checkpoint prior to entering the building. The building is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

YOU MUST HAVE A PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TO ENTER THE BUILDING.
